### **DARE Graduation: Friday, December 11<sup>th</sup> 2:45-3:45pm**

Throughout their elementary careers, students have participated in DARE (Drug Awareness Resistance Education) with our Officer Stubbs, DARE Officer. The 6<sup>th</sup> grade year is the end of the elementary program and students "graduate" with a program led by Mrs. Opie and the new DARE Officer this year, Austin Hicks. Cupcakes/drinks will be served. In case of inclement weather, the reschedule date is Thursday, December 17<sup>th</sup> from 2:45 to 3:45pm.

### **Skating Party: Thursday, October 29<sup>th</sup> 10:30am to 12:30pm**

CCE Celebrates Halloween with classroom parties and a parade of students in costume. 6<sup>th</sup> grade does not participate in this event as they prepare to become Middle Schoolers, they are simply an audience for the parade. Instead, they go on a Skating outing – set for October 29 from 10:30 - 12:30. Afterwards, students return to school and have pizza, salad and dessert in the cafeteria. It's a really fun event for the kids to get to hang out for a few hours with their friends.

### **Grandparents Breakfast: Monday, November 23<sup>rd</sup> 7:15am to 8:45am**

The awesome event is for Grandparents and Special Friends to come and visit the school while eating a yummy breakfast and raising money for 6<sup>th</sup> grade. The 6<sup>th</sup> class students greet, serve, clear and clean during the event. Tickets are purchased in advance and at the door, with net proceeds going to fund some of the 6<sup>th</sup> grade events, the Harvester donation and Class Legacy Gift.

### **Harvesters Day Trip: Tuesday, February 9<sup>th</sup> 10:00am to 12:00pm**

The 6<sup>th</sup> Grade will go on a field trip to learn about Harvesters, how they help the community and will also participate by helping to bag up groceries. Part of the Grandparents fundraiser will allow the students to donate a check to Harvesters. Please plan to also send 6 canned good items with your child as an additional donation (6 for 6<sup>th</sup> grade!) This event is coordinated through the school, volunteers (4 from each class) and permission slip information will come out from the classroom teachers in January.

### **6<sup>th</sup> Grade T-Shirt**

Each year the class has a t-shirt made that they wear it to the Harvesters Day and then any other day they would like. Shirts are usually in the \$5-6 range, partially paid for by the fundraiser.

### **6<sup>th</sup> Grade Video (Photos set to music)**

This is a cool keepsake you can purchase for \$14.95 that will include 5 pictures of each student that your family supplies to the committee in charge. You will provide a flash drive with electronic pictures or printed pictures – consisting of a baby picture, a kindergarten picture, a recent 6<sup>th</sup> grade picture and 2 candids. It's best to keep the pictures of the child mostly. Pictures are due by February 1<sup>st</sup>, more information will be coming soon!

### **6<sup>th</sup> Grade Legacy Gift**

Each 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Class gives a gift to the school as a legacy of their time at CCE. Examples include benches, rugs, a sign by the track and a scrolling sign in the cafeteria. The students will be presented with a few options to vote on later in the school year.

### **Ecology Fishing Trip: Date TBD**

This is a classroom sponsored field trip to James A. Reed to go along ecology unit. Students will take a bus and do a variety of activities, such as testing the water, logging insects and critters and fishing. This is a great field trip for Dads and Grandads!

### **6<sup>th</sup> Grade Recognition: Date TBD**

Time to recognize all the 6<sup>th</sup> grade students for all their accomplishments over the last year(s). Each student receives a certificate of 6<sup>th</sup> grade completion. This is also where the 6<sup>th</sup> grade photo/video plays. Choir sings...and sometimes other musical numbers. Refreshments are provided.

### **6<sup>th</sup> Grade End of Year Party: Date TBD**

This is a party put on by a committee of 6<sup>th</sup> grade moms/dads. The party is for all 6<sup>th</sup> grade students and is during school hours, but not at the school. Transportation is provided. At this point, we have not made plans for the location, but stay tuned we'll have a location and date sometime after Christmas.
